Digital Pioneers Academy PCS submits to the DC Public Charter School Board this application to amend its charter agreement by changing the item(s) selected above. If approved, this amendment will be effective on July 22, 2019 (leave blank if this has not been determined).

Digital Pioneers Academy PCS is proposing a charter amendment for a location change from 915 12th Street SE to 709 12th Street SE. We are creating this change in order to be able to house our charter to its full maturity of 360 scholars. Our current location does not have the capacity to house all of our scholars for next school year.

The new location will also be a stand alone location and we will not be sharing the building with other organizations as we have done this school year. We will be able to have greater space for instruction for our classrooms as well as additional spaces for services provided to our scholars.

2. How will the proposed amendment(s) support or enhance the school's mission?

The proposed amendment will allow for Digital Pioneers Academy to fully enroll for its forecasted 360 scholars in grades 6-8 in one location. This space will be able to accommodate our entire student body. It will also create additional spaces for our scholars to be able to participate in multiple "acceleration" or elective options. We currently are only able to offer robotics as our non-physical education elective offering. With the additional space we will be able to potentially offer additional accelerations that our scholars have shown interest in including chess, Spanish, studio art, and theater. This will allow our scholars to grow and develop in fields outside of Computer Science.

Digital Pioneers Academy PCS has not received any notices of concerns, board actions, or community complaints. We also have not had an audit conducted yet due to us being in our first year of existence.

Digital Pioneers Academy PCS has not had a Financial Audit Review yet. The proposed amendment would have an increased rent cost for our school as well as renovations and building maintenance costs. We will be able to still finance these costs with our per pupil facilities revenue.

Digital Pioneers Academy PCS has already informed the East Washington Heights Baptist Church community, Kenneth Lesley the Education Committee Chair of the Hillcrest Community Civic Association, our local police officers, and other local stakeholders of us leaving our current location including our current neighboring Elementary Schools.
