PROPOSAL

The Family Place, PCS submits to the DC Public Charter School Board this application to amend its charter agreement by changing the item(s) selected above. If approved, this amendment will be effective on ______, 20_____ (leave blank if this has not been determined).

In our first year of operation our total UPSFF was 130 students but our ceiling was set at 120 so we did not receive funding for the additional 10 students. We project to have around the same number of students this year and thus would like to increase our ceiling by a de minimis amount of 6 students (or 5%).

2. How will the proposed amendment(s) support or enhance the school's mission?

The proposed amendment would allow us to better support our student body by providing funding for additional educational coaches to allow one-on-one time for struggling students and for test preparation.

There have been no notices of concern about our school. Year 2019-20 is only our second year in operation, but we do not project to have any issues of concern.

This is only our second year in operation, and we are in the midst of our first financial audit with KJP. According to our internal financial information we ended the year with 137 days of cash and a 32% gross margin. This has allowed us to set some funding aside for investing in a larger space as our enrollment increases in year 3 (140 ceiling) and year 5 (175 ceiling) according to our charter application.
