**SUMMARY:** The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (“PCSB”) announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on a request to the 2015-16 PMF Policy & Technical Guide submitted by DC PCSB staff on December 14, 2015.

Pursuant to the School Reform Act, D.C. Code 38-1802 et seq., a charter school must submit a petition to revise its charter, which includes its enrollment ceiling.

- Comments must be submitted on or before January 25, 2016.
