

For schools serving grades PK-12, DC PCSB uses the **Performance Management** Framework (PMF) to assess school-wide academic performance. Schools are rated by tiers: Tier 1 schools meet standards of high performance; Tier 2 schools fall short of high performance standards but meet minimum overall performance standards; and Tier 3 schools fall significantly short of high performance standards, showing inadequate performance.

We offer a full-day program, including early morning and extended day, that is characterized by individualized, student-centered instruction; hands-on curriculum; and multi-age classrooms led by certified Montessori teachers. Our model emphasizes early intervention from age 3 with equal weight placed on academic, social, and emotional development. Breakthrough seeks to graduate students with the academic and social skills necessary to excel in their future schools, complete post-secondary education, and build rewarding careers and vocations.
