# **Adult Education Performance Management Framework**

# Five Key Indicators

The Adult Education PMF measures the performance of adult education charter schools on five indicators:

- **Student Progress** - learning gains as measured by tests for adults and disengaged youth
- **Student Achievement** - successful completion of secondary requirements through GED or NEDP attainment
- **Career and College Readiness** - entering postsecondary education or training and/or entering or retaining employment
- **Leading Indicators** - student attendance and retention
- **Mission Specific Goals** - aspects of the school program otherwise not captured

# AE PMF Tiers

## **Tier 1 (High Performing)**

Schools earning a Tier 1 status must meet or exceed a weighted range score of 65.0% on all indicators.

## **Tier 2 (Mid Performing)**

Schools earning a Tier 2 status must meet or exceed a weighted range score of 35.0% on all indicators.

## **Tier 3 (Low Performing)**

Schools earning a Tier 3 status do not meet the 35.0% weighted range score on any of the indicators.
