



Notice of Petition to Amend Charter:
Goals and Academic Achievement Expectations –**Center City
Public Charter School**

ACTION: Open for Public Comment

PUBLIC COMMENT ACCEPTED UNTIL: **September 18, 2017**

SUMMARY: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (“PCSB”) announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on a request to amend its charter goals and academic achievement expectations submitted by Center City PCS on August 4, 2017.

Currently in its 10th year of operation, Center City PCS serves students in grades PK3 through 8th grade. The school will be up for 10-Year Charter Review in SY 2017-18. Effective immediately, the school would like to amend its goals and academic achievement expectations to adopt DC PCSB’s Performance Management Framework as its performance targets.

Pursuant to the School Reform Act, D.C. Code 38-1802 et seq., a charter school must submit a petition to revise its charter, which includes its charter goals and academic achievement expectations.
