Highlights


- Ward 5 has 29 public charter schools serving 9,747 students and 15 DCPS schools serving 4,435 students.
- Of the 6,285 public charter school students living in Ward 5, 2,873 attend public charter schools that are located in Ward 5.
- Ward 5 has 23 schools that serve elementary grades, greater than other grade levels.


