



Notice of Petition to Amend Charter:
Enrollment Ceiling Increase/Campus Name Change – **Eagle Academy PCS**
ACTION: **Open for Public Comment**
PUBLIC COMMENT ACCEPTED UNTIL: **December 18, 2017**

SUMMARY: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board ("DC PCSB") announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on an application submitted by Eagle Academy Public Charter School ("Eagle Academy PCS") on November 2, 2017 to amend its charter by revising its existing enrollment ceiling and changing the name of one of its campuses.

Eagle Academy PCS is currently in its fifteenth year of operation serving students in grades prekindergarten-3 through third at two campuses located in Wards 6 and 8. Effective for school year (SY) 2018-2019, the school requests an enrollment ceiling increase of 90 students, from its existing maximum ceiling of 920 students to a new maximum ceiling of 1,010 students, to allow increased enrollment at the new facility where its Capitol Riverfront campus will relocate to in SY 2018-2019. Once relocated, the school also requests the Capitol Riverfront campus be renamed *Eagle Academy PCS at Fairlawn*.

Pursuant to the School Reform Act, D.C. Code 38-1802 et seq., a charter school must submit a petition to revise its charter, which includes its enrollment ceiling and campus names.
