







DFBT

\$198,210 outstanding on a \$350,000 revolving Line of Credit from East West Bank with an initial maturity date of November 14, 2015, extended to January 14, 2017. This line bears interest at a variable rate of prime+2.0%. If the school did not have this line of credit, it would have had less than one day of cash on hand.

FACILITIES:

\$322,673 in rent expense for lease agreement of a school building located at 62 T St, NE. The lease expires June 30, 2019, with an option to renew for an additional five years. Rent abatement in the first year of the lease has resulted in a \$198,548 deferred rent liability at year-end.

The CEO and Superintendent of Schools for Harmony Public Schools was the board president of Harmony DC PCS throughout the fiscal year and the Harmony Public Schools Director of Communications served as a Harmony DC PCS board member through April 2016.

Harmony Public Schools provides education technology services, data network solutions, teacher and leadership coaching, human resources, and financial services to the School. In addition, the School uses trademarks, licensed marks, and other intellectual property owned by Harmony Public Schools. Transactions between the two organizations in 2016 include:

\$49,358 as a donated license fee, and \$32,209 for both School services and reimbursable expenses.
