

SUMMARY: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (DC PCSB) announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on a request submitted by Ideal Academy Public Charter School (Ideal Academy PCS) on February 2, 2018 to amend its goals and academic achievement expectations.

Ideal Academy PCS is currently in its nineteenth year of operation serving students in grades prekindergarten-3 through eighth at a single campus in Ward 4. Ideal Academy PCS previously adopted the Performance Management Framework (PMF) as its measure for goals and academic achievement expectations. If approved, Ideal Academy PCS proposes to earn a PMF score of 77% for SY 2017-2018 to meet the proposed target average of 58% for SY 2016-2017 and SY 2017-2018 or demonstrate evidence of substantial improvement in its PMF.

Pursuant to the School Reform Act, D.C. Code 38-1802 et seq., a charter school must submit a petition to revise its charter, which includes its goals and academic achievement.
