

Notice of Petition to Amend Charter: Goals and Academic Achievement Expectations –**KIPP DC PCS**

ACTION: Open for Public Comment

PUBLIC COMMENT ACCEPTED UNTIL: October 23, 2017

SUMMARY: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board ("DC PCSB") announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on a request submitted by KIPP DC Public Charter School ("KIPP DC PCS") on August 28, 2017 to revise its existing goals and academic achievement expectations effective for SY 2017-2018.

KIPP DC PCS is requesting the following two changes to its goals, in which neither revision changes the school's target or response rate requirement:

1. Current Goal: KIPP DC families will support our schools, as measured by survey results, and at least 75% of our surveyed parents will state that "I am proud that my child attends KIPP" in the annual KIPP Healthy Schools and Regions survey with at least 50% response rate.

Proposed Revision: KIPP DC families will support our schools, as measured by survey results, and at least 75% of our surveyed parents will state that "I am proud that my child attends KIPP" in the annual KIPP DC Parent survey with at least a 50% response rate.

Rationale: This change only impacts the survey tool. KIPP Foundation issues their current parent survey (KIPP Healthy Schools and Regions) entirely online, and as a result, KIPP DC PCS has been unable to obtain the 50% parent response rate required by the goal. The school is developing a similar survey that can be administered on paper.

2. Current Goal: KIPP DC teachers will support our schools, as measured by survey results, and at least 75% of our surveyed teachers will state that "My school's mission is important to me" in the annual KIPP Healthy Schools and Regions survey with at least a 50% response rate.

Proposed Revision: KIPP DC teachers will support our schools, as measured by survey results, and at least 75% of our surveyed teachers will state that "I am proud to work for KIPP DC" in the annual KIPP DC Teacher survey with at least a 50% response rate.

Rationale: This change impacts the survey tool and the statement. KIPP Foundation discontinued its teacher survey and KIPP DC PCS has since developed a teacher survey using the CultureAmp platform. KIPP DC PCS wants the goals to reference this new survey.

Pursuant to the School Reform Act, D.C. Code 38-1802 et seq., a charter school must submit a petition to revise its charter, which includes its goals and academic achievement expectations.
