# What are the Reasons for the Change?

We heard your feedback:

- Early Childhood assessments are not comparable
- Multiple PMFs for one campus is confusing to families
- Multiple PMFs makes accountability confusing to schools
- The EC PMF alone does not appear to measure quality



## Why a campus level PMF

- Simplicity—easy for parents and schools
- One campus—with one leader and academic philosophy and program—should be measured by its totality, not each part separately
- PCSB Accountability Vision—it has been the vision since the beginning to have a campus PMF for accountability purposes



What is PCSB Proposing?

## **Overview of Changes**

- The campus-level PMF creates ONE PMF for all schools serving grades PK3 – 8
- Scale/weights adjusted so that all schools are comparable, regardless of start and end grades
- Attendance and re-enrollment for all students (not artificially divided at 2<sup>nd</sup> grade)
- Plans for NO TIERS for new EC/ES/MS in 2014/15

  - 2-year weighted\* CLASS scores for all three domains (if applicable)

- NWEA MAP Typical Growth for all grades K 2
- Achievement
  - NWEA MAP for all grades K 2
- Gateway
  - Schools ending in grades K 3 will not have a gateway
- School Environment
  - Attendance for all students
  - Re-enrollment for all students
  - 2-year weighted\* CLASS scores for all three domains (if applicable)

## **Business Rules**

## **EC** Assessments

#### <u>PK Assessments</u> – Display Only

 Display data based on publisher guidance: growth or achievement

#### <u>K-2 Assessments</u> – Display Only

 PMF will display achievement only based on publisher guidance. Most assessments have achievement only

#### Only for schools ending in grades K, 1, 2, or 3

#### NWEA MAP Achievement

Achievement level: To be set at the 60<sup>th</sup> percentile with adjusted floors and targets\*

#### \*Input needed: To be discussed April 2



**Business Rules:** 

**Floors** = calculated based on the lowest 10<sup>th</sup> percentile of charter school performance over the past three years where the most recent year has 50% weight, the previous year has 30% weight and the year prior to that has 20% weight

<u>**Targets</u>** = calculated based on the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile of charter school performance over the past three years where the most recent year has 50% weight, the previous year has 30% weight and the year prior to that has 20% weight</u>

\*If the range between the 10<sup>th</sup> and 90<sup>th</sup> percentiles is less than 10, we take the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile and subtract 10

#### **Business Rule determined floors and targets:**
