



Notice of Petition to Amend Charter:  
Goals and Academic Achievement Expectations – **Meridian PCS**  
ACTION: Open for Public Comment  
PUBLIC COMMENT ACCEPTED UNTIL: **April 23, 2018**

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**SUMMARY:** The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (DC PCSB) announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on a request submitted by Meridian Public Charter School (Meridian PCS) on March 5, 2018 to amend its goals and academic achievement expectations.

Meridian PCS is currently in its 18<sup>th</sup> year of operation serving students in grades prekindergarten-3 through eighth. Given DC PCSB recently revised its Performance Management Framework (PMF) as Goals policy, the school requests to adopt the newest guidelines as its measure for goals and academic achievement expectations.

Pursuant to the School Reform Act, D.C. Code 38-1802 et seq., a charter school must submit a petition to revise its charter, which includes its goals and academic achievement expectations.
