



Notice of Petition to Amend Charter:
Goals and Academic Achievement Expectations – **Monument
Academy Public Charter School**

ACTION: Open for Public Comment

PUBLIC COMMENT ACCEPTED UNTIL: **September 18, 2017**

SUMMARY: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board ("PCSB") announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on a request to amend its charter goals and academic achievement expectations submitted by Monument Academy PCS on August 4, 2017.

Monument Academy PCS, currently in its second year of operation serving students in grades 5-7 (eventually serving through grade 8) wishes to revise its goals to more accurately reflect its school program and the unique population the school is serving, made up of a large percentage of at-risk students. These newly revised charter goals will also replace the school's goals under the Alternative Accountability Framework.

Pursuant to the School Reform Act, D.C. Code 38-1802 et seq., a charter school must submit a petition to revise its charter, which includes its charter goals and academic achievement expectations.

- Comments must be submitted on or before September 18, 2017.
