



Notice of Petition to Amend Charter:  
Facility Location – **Rocketship DC PCS**

ACTION: Open for Public Comment

PUBLIC COMMENT ACCEPTED UNTIL: **May 22, 2017**

**SUMMARY:** The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (“PCSB”) announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on a request to temporarily co-locate its Ward 7 campus at two separate locations, submitted by Rocketship PCS on April 3, 2017. Under this proposal, the school’s kindergarten through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students will be served on the campus of Rocketship Rise Academy at 2335 Reynolds Place SE, while PK-3 and PK-4 students will locate at AppleTree PCS’s Oklahoma Avenue site at 330 21<sup>st</sup> St NE. The PK3 and PK4 students will remain at the Oklahoma Ave site for the entirety of School Year 2017-18 and move to Rocketship DC PCS’s permanent site the following school year, while the kindergarten through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students will move to the permanent campus once construction is completed, midyear during the 2017-18 school year.

Pursuant to the School Reform Act, D.C. Code 38-1802 et seq., a charter school must submit a petition to revise its charter, which includes its enrollment ceiling.
