	70% of NEDP students entering the Assessment Phase of the program will earn a high school diploma within a year.	
	75% of students who take the Internet and Computing Core Certification (IC3) exam will pass the exam	<i>Remove this measure from the student achievement indicator.</i>
Career/ College Readiness	75% of learners with post-secondary goal will enter a postsecondary educational, occupational skills training program, or an apprenticeship training program	<i>Replace with AE PMF College/Career Readiness measures as assessed by Accuplacer, data matching and/or follow-up surveys.</i>
	On an annual basis, 75% of individuals who have the goal of earning a college degree will place into credit bearing courses at post-secondary institutions.	
	70% of students who graduate with employment goal will obtain or retain employment, receive a promotion or wage increases
