

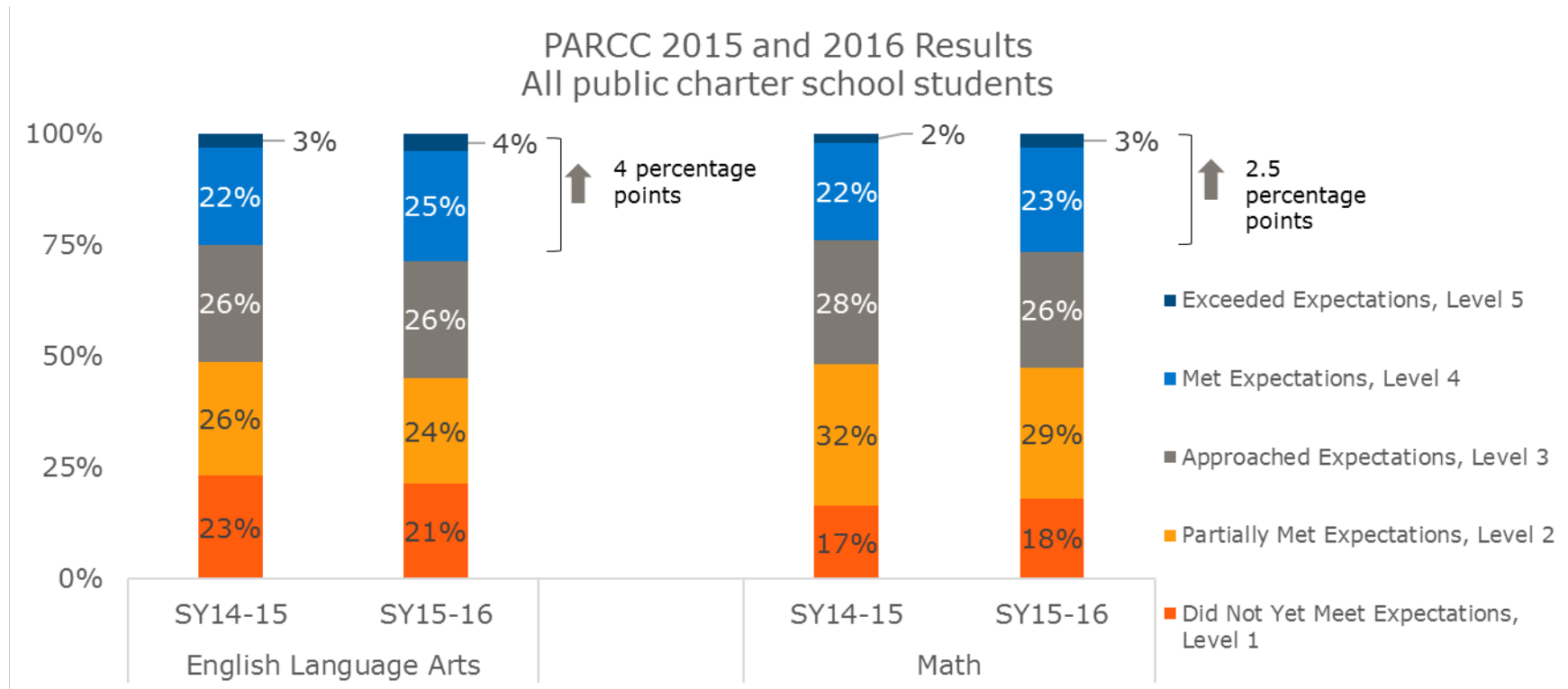

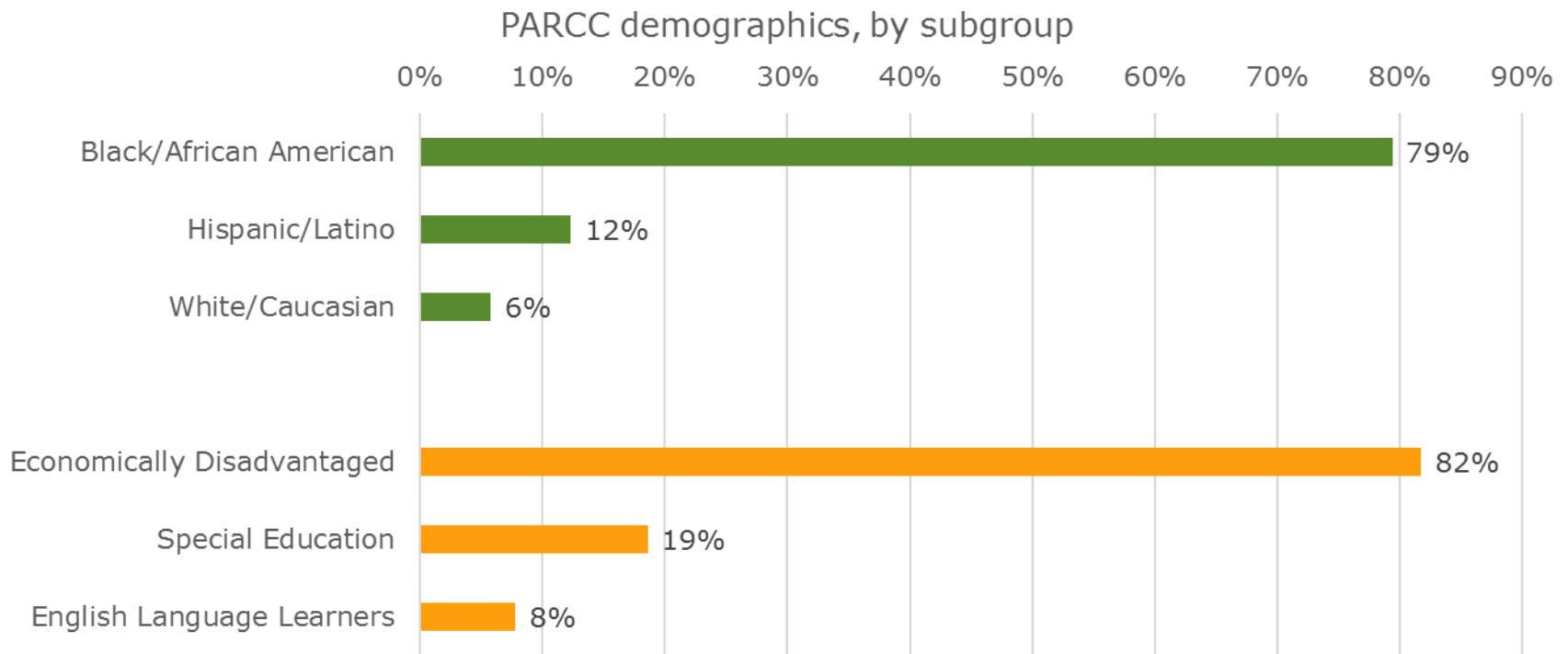
English Language Arts and Math, all grades

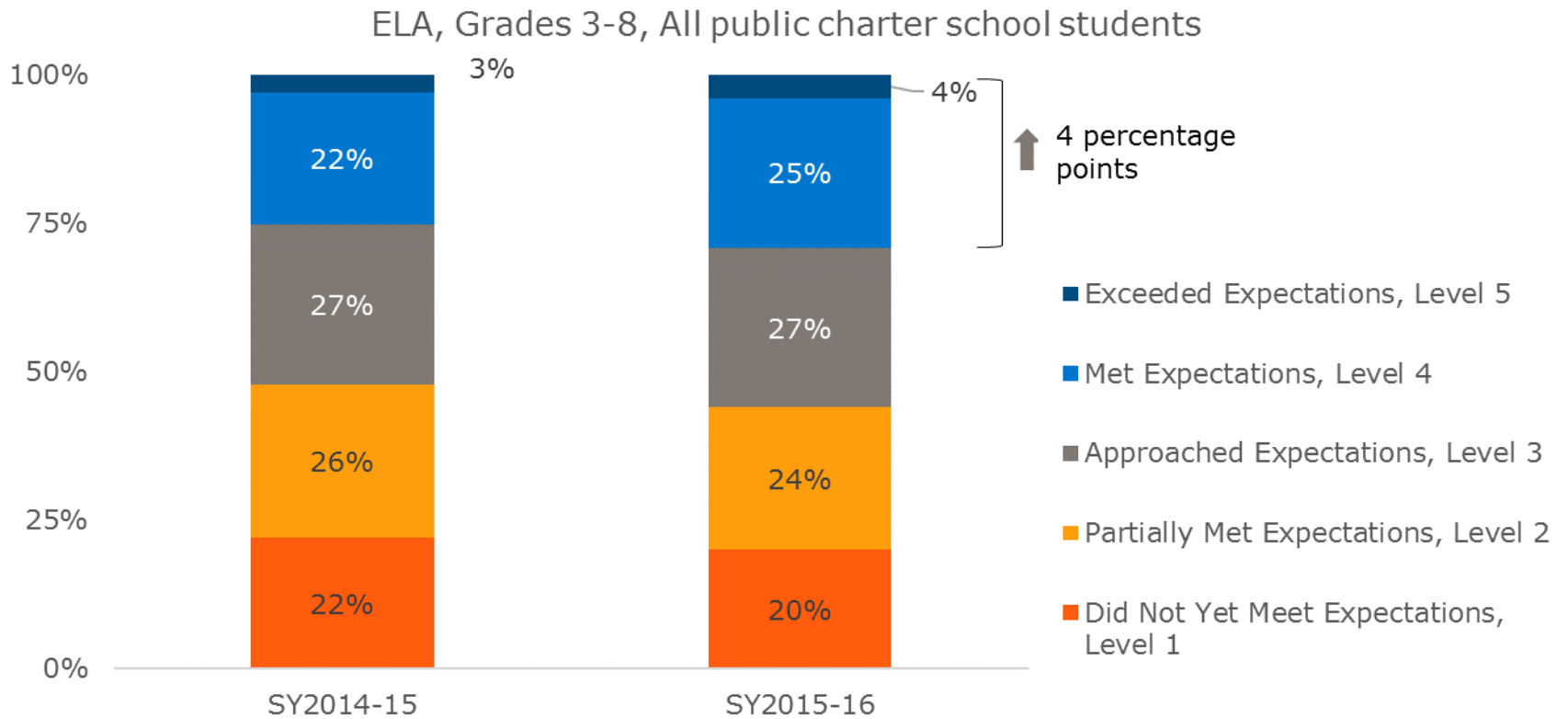

English Language Arts Grades 3-8

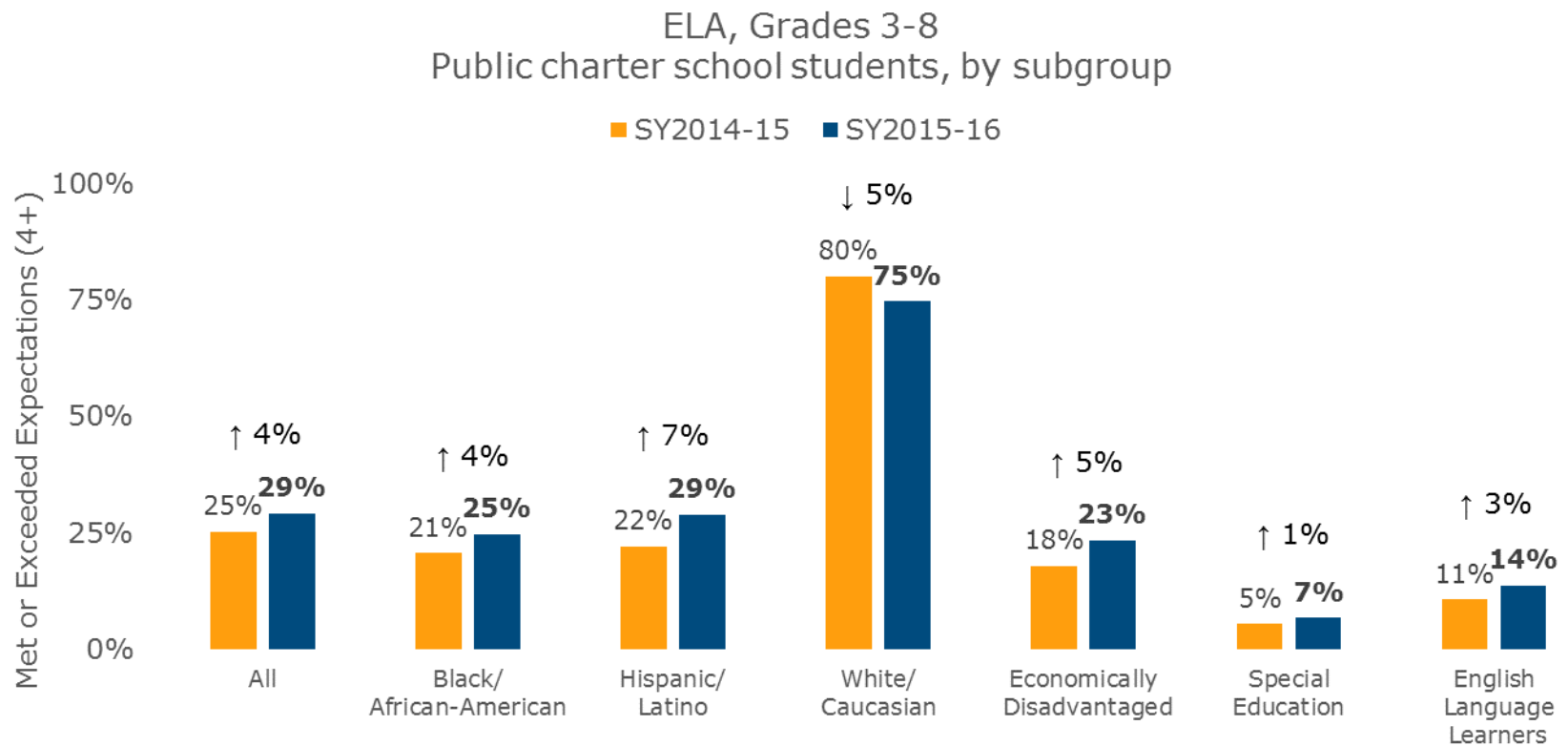

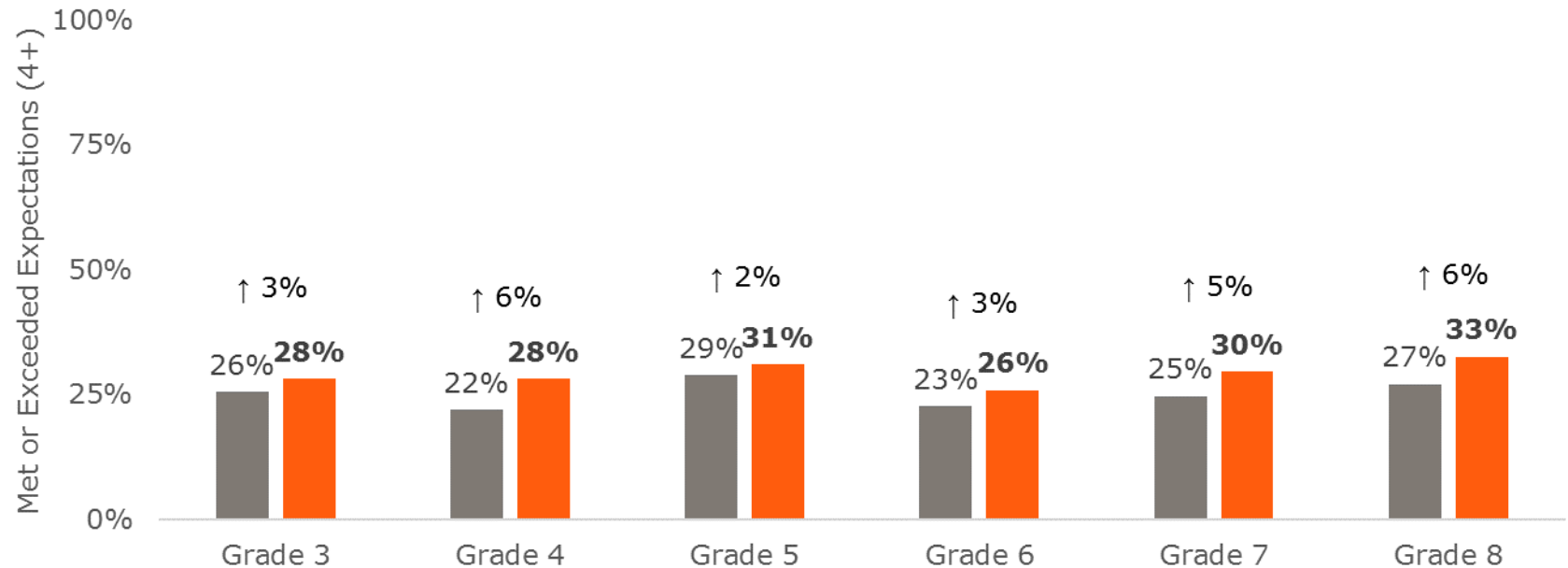

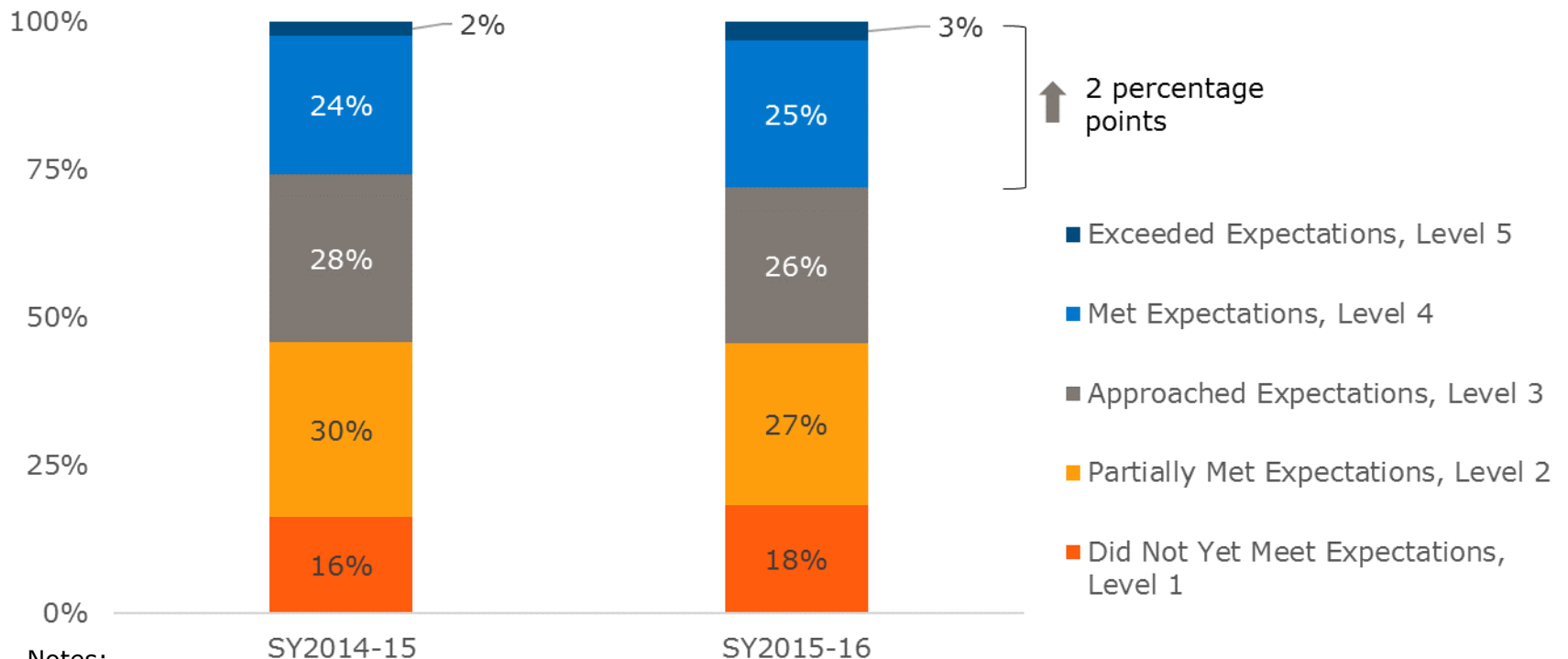

By subgroup, Met or Exceeded Expectations (4+)

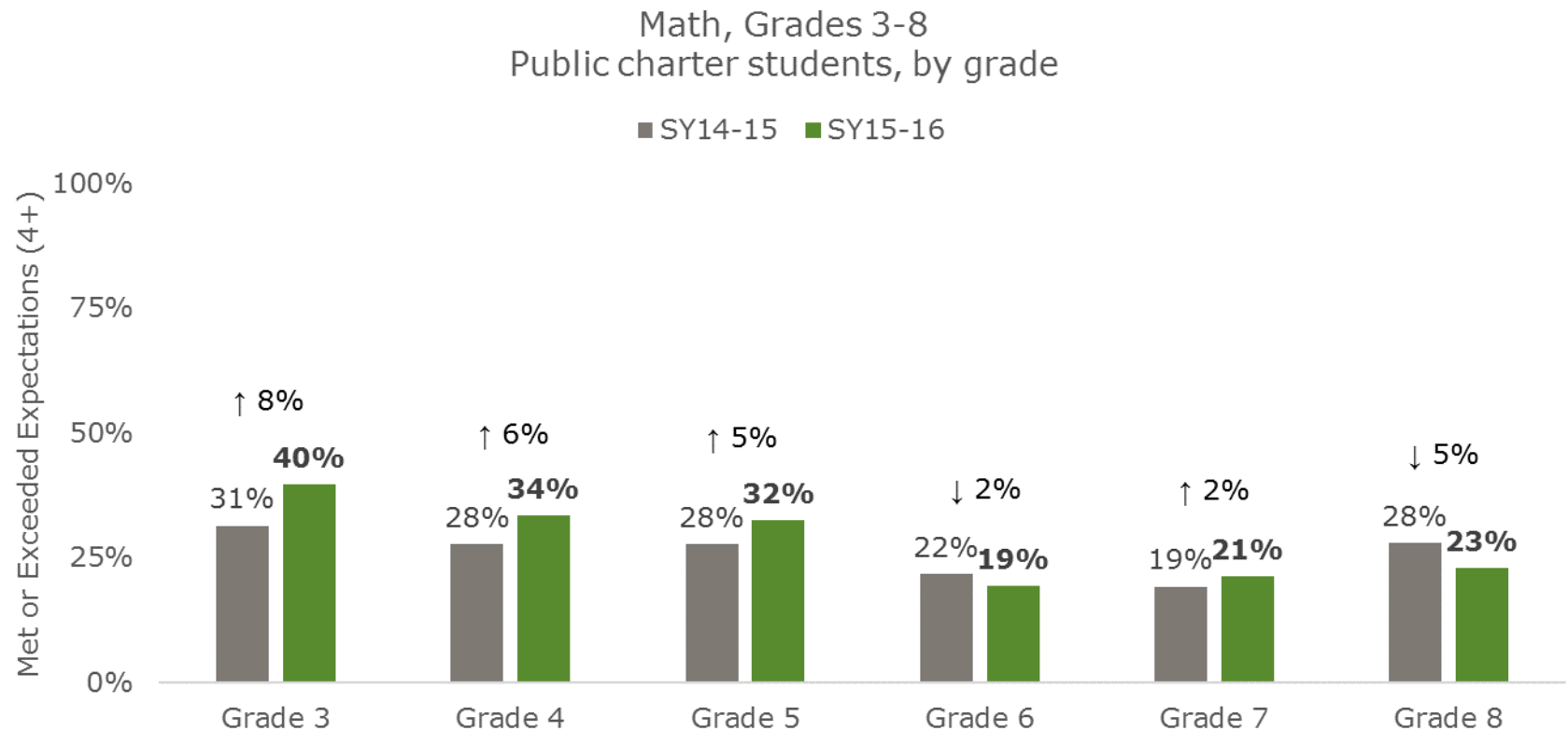

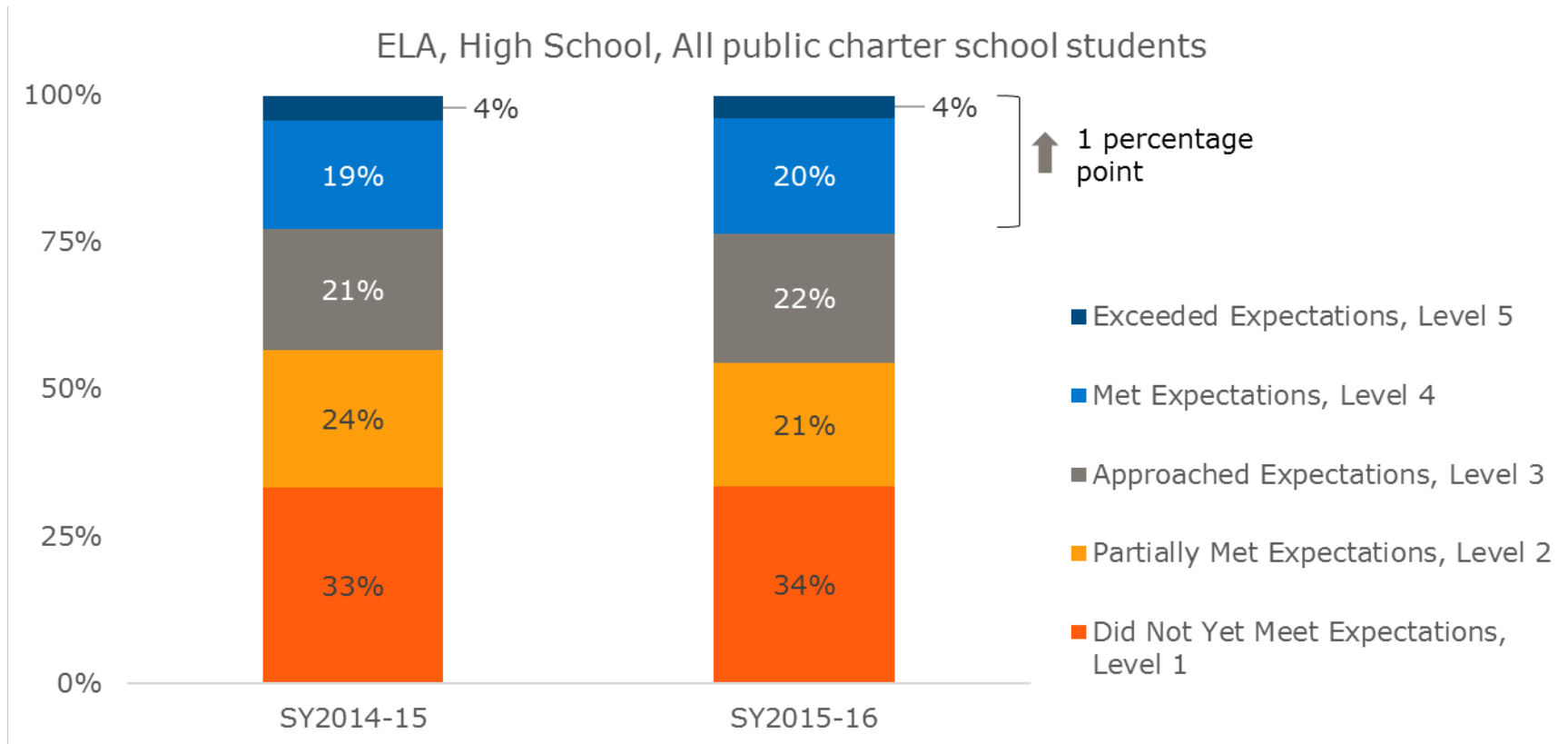

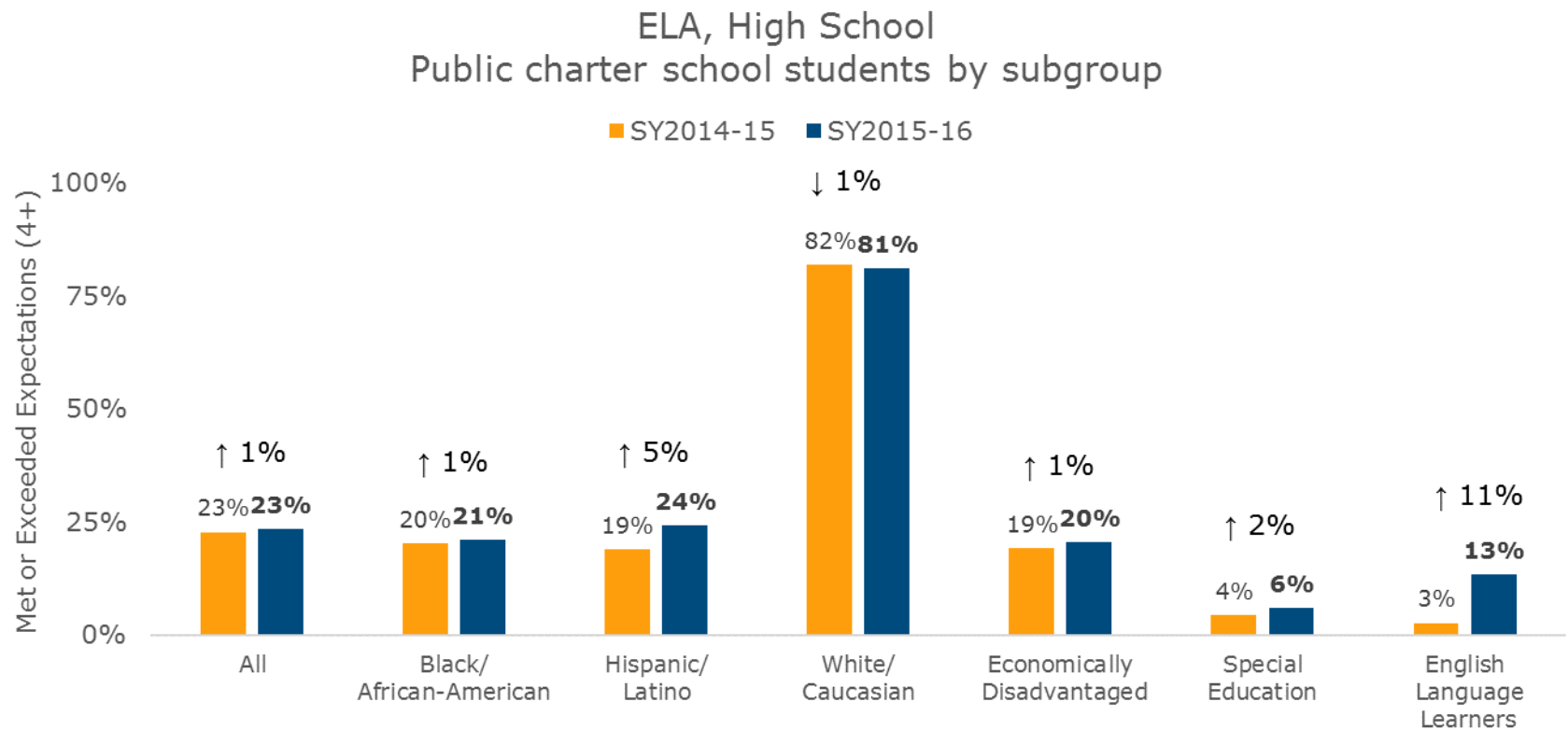

English Language Arts, High School

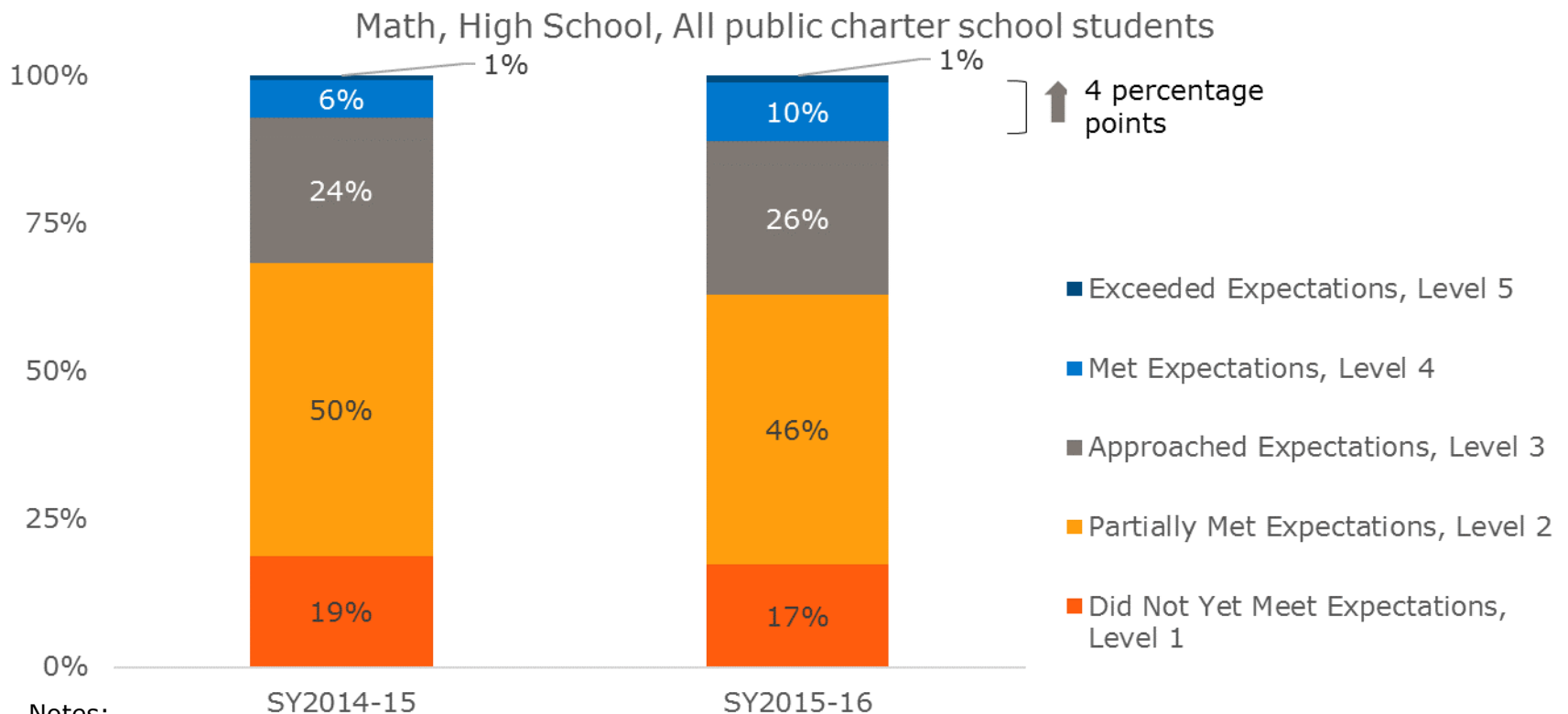
By subgroup, Met or Exceeded Expectations (4+)

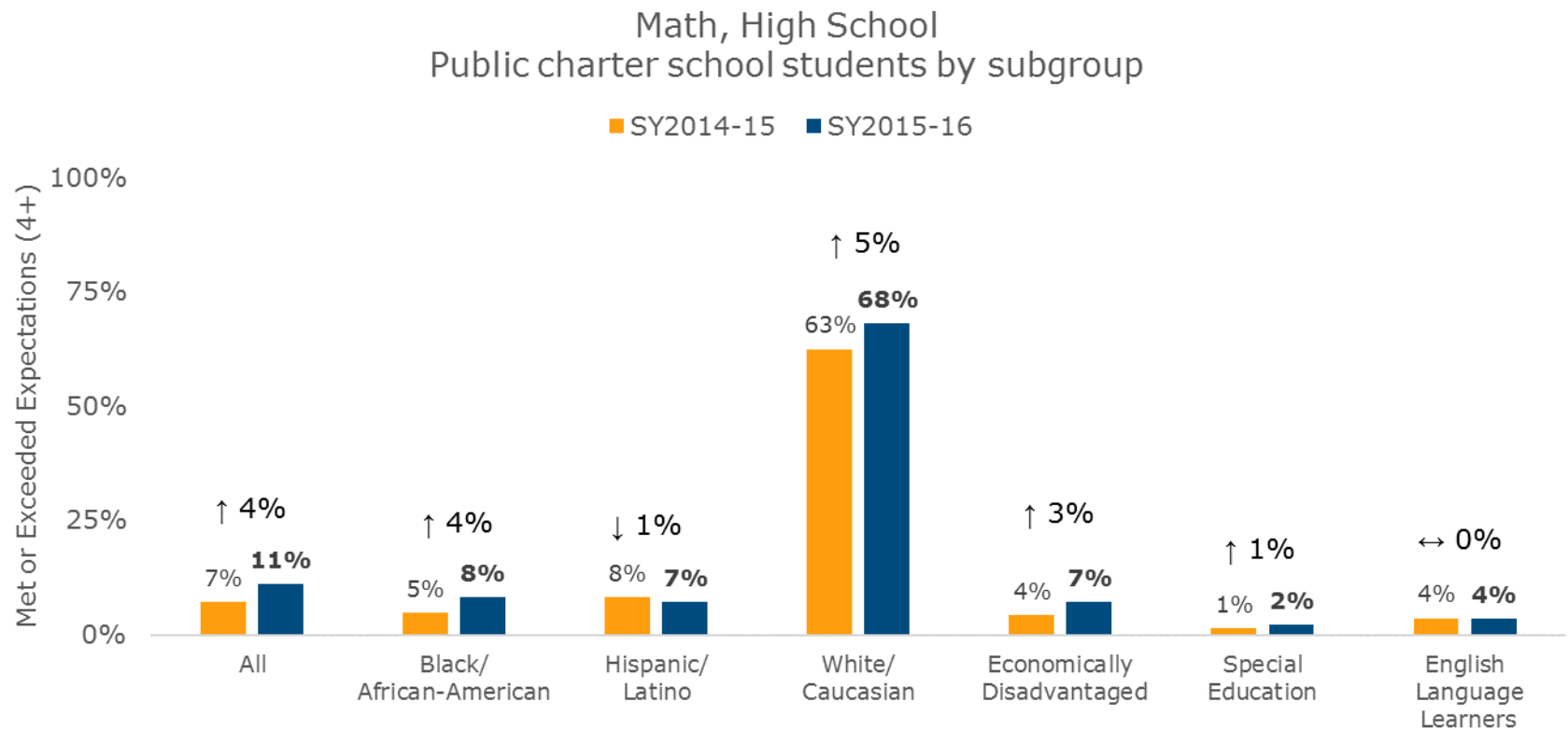


Math High school

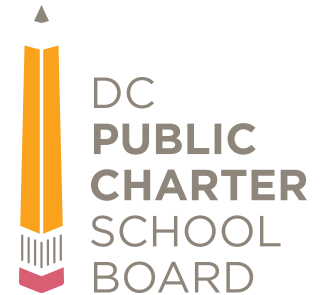
