


PARCC 2016 and 2015 Results English Language Arts and Math, all grades






Math, Grades 3-8 By subgroup, Met or Exceeded Expectations (4+)








Math, Grades 3-8 By grade, Met or Exceeded Expectations (4+)




English Language Arts, High School By subgroup, Met or Exceeded Expectations (4+)










