**SUMMARY:** The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (“PCSB”) announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on a request to amend its charter’s goals and academic expectations submitted by Two Rivers Public Charter School (“Two Rivers PCS”) on October 24, 2014.

Pursuant to the School Reform Act, D.C. Code 38-1802 et seq., a charter school must submit a petition to revise its charter, which includes its goals and academic expectations.

- Comments must be submitted on or before January 26, 2015.
