



Notice of Request to Amend Charter
Grade Expansion– **Eagle Academy PCS**
Open for Public Comment

Public Comment Accepted Until September 19, 2022

SUMMARY: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (DC PCSB) announces an opportunity for the public to comment on a request from Eagle Academy Public Charter School (Eagle Academy PCS) to amend its charter agreement. The school seeks authorization to expand its program to grade 4 in school year (SY) 2023 – 24 and grade 5 in SY 2024 – 25 at both campuses. The school submitted its request on June 7, 2022.¹

Currently, in its 19th year of operation, Eagle Academy PCS educates over 500 students in grades prekindergarten 3 (PK3) through 3 across two campuses in Wards 6 and 8. Eagle Academy PCS's mission is "to build the foundation for a promising future for all students in a rich, robust learning environment that fosters creativity and problem-solving abilities".
