

Notice of Request to Amend Charter Facility – **Social Justice PCS**Open for Public Comment

Public Comment Accepted Until May 20, 2024

SUMMARY: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (DC PCSB) announces an opportunity for the public to comment on a request from Social Justice Public Charter School (PCS) to amend its charter by adding a second facility. Social Justice PCS proposes operating from 5335 1st Place NE (Ward 5) for school year (SY) 2024 – 25 and at least part of SY 2025 – 26.1

Founded in SY 2020 – 21, Social Justice PCS enrolls 115 students in grades 5 through 8. Its mission is "Social Justice [PCS] will catalyze an integrated community of middle school students, 5^{th} – 8^{th} grade, to be scholar-activists who are designers of a more just world."

The school is experiencing permitting delays at its recently approved facility at 333 Kennedy Street NE (Ward 5). Until the site is ready for students, Social Justice PCS will temporarily locate from Impact DMV Church at 5335 1st Place NE (Ward 5). Once the school moves to 333 Kennedy Street, the school will continue to rent space from the church for physical education classes.
