

SUMMARY: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (DC PCSB) announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on a request from BASIS DC Public Charter School (PCS) to amend its charter agreement by expanding its enrollment ceiling and grades served. The school submitted its request on May 6, 2024.¹

Currently in its 12th year of operation, BASIS DC PCS educates 690 students in grades 5 through 12 in a single facility located in Ward 2. The school has a current enrollment ceiling of 711 students.

BASIS DC PCS seeks an expansion amendment to increase its enrollment ceiling and to add kindergarten (K) – 4 to its grades served. In school year (SY) 2025 – 26, the school proposes opening grades K – 4 simultaneously with an initial enrollment of 318 students. Over the next three years, the school plans to increase its enrollment ceiling by 516 to total 1,227 students across grades K – 12.
