

Notice of Petition to Amend Charter: Competency-Based Unit Waiver – **BASIS DC PCS** Open for Public Comment

Public Comment Accepted Until October 27, 2025

SUMMARY: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (DC PCSB) announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on a request from BASIS DC Public Charter School (PCS) to amend the graduation requirements in its charter agreement. The school submitted its request on August 29, 2025.¹

Currently in its 13th year of operation, BASIS DC PCS educates 698 students in grades 5 – 12 in one facility in Ward 2. The school's mission is to "provide an academically excellent and rigorous liberal arts college preparatory education available to all middle and high school students of the District of Columbia."

BASIS DC PCS requests approval to offer competency-based credits in place of Carnegie units for students in grades 6 – 8 who demonstrate mastery of Algebra I, II, and Geometry content. Eligible students may earn 1.5 competency-based credits each for passing the courses Algebra I & Geometry and Algebra II & Geometry.
