- 3. 5:10-5:25pm: Executive Director's Report
  - a. Met enrollment target
  - b. Financial indicators are strong; additional grant money coming soon from OSSE (\$80K facilities grant, \$80K for hiring staff to manage COVID mitigation and response, \$10K for contact tracing, \$43K for COVID testing)
  - c. COVID has been extremely disruptive
    - i. 16 positive cases
    - ii. 8/13 classes have had to quarantine
    - iii. 63% of students have had to guarantine
    - iv. Working with Shield T-3 for COVID testing, by Nov 1, must be testing >20% of students each week, goal is 100%
  - d. General academics
    - i. Week 8 of classes
    - ii. DESSA and DECA administered (social-emotional), ASQ (developmental screener)
    - iii. TS Gold and iReady administered (academic)
      - 1. Robust reading intervention plans in place
      - 2. Plan for math support still in development given lost time for working with Montessori manipulatives for math
    - iv. Are other schools in the district being impacted in the same way? Breakthrough seems to be on the high end of the distribution in terms of numbers of cases, but not an outlier
      - 1. Breakthrough opened a week before DCPS, when case rates were higher, plus gave us a week head start
      - DCPS schools only testing 10% of their student body;Breakthrough is testing more, so catching more positive cases
    - v. Special education program being redesigned to leverage a Resource Room for small group instruction with additional supports for children receiving special education services
      - 1. Some classrooms now require multiple dedicated aides, which is resulting in a lot of adults in the room
