NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY

THE FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT (FERPA)

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), a Federal law, requires that Maya Angelou Public Charter Schools, with certain exceptions, obtain your written consent prior to the disclosure of personal identifiable information from your child's education records.
