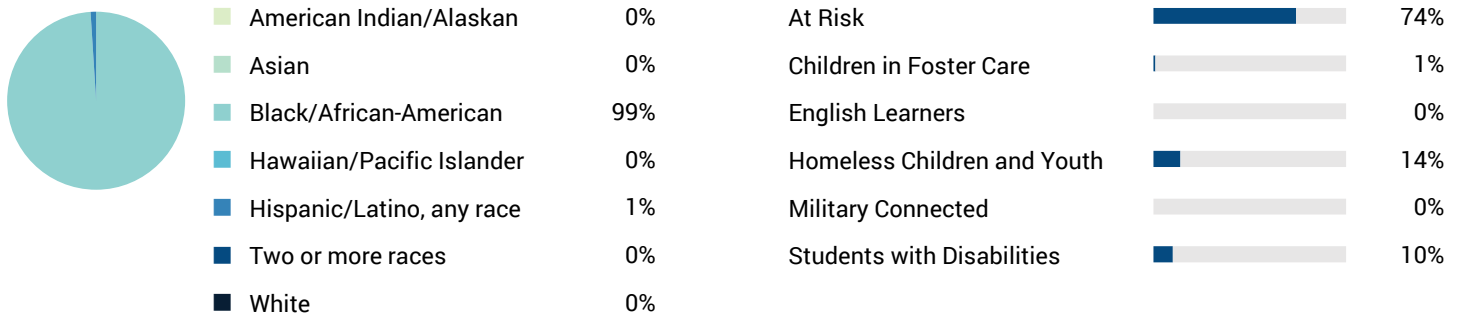
MESSAGE FROM THE SCHOOL
