



Notice of Petition to Amend Charter:
Goals and Academic Achievement Expectations – **Academy of Hope PCS**

ACTION: Open for Public Comment
PUBLIC COMMENT ACCEPTED UNTIL: **September 17, 2018**

SUMMARY: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (DC PCSB) announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on a request submitted by Academy of Hope Adult Public Charter School (Academy of Hope PCS) on August 3, 2018 for an amendment to its goals and academic achievement expectations.

Academy of Hope PCS is in its fourth year of operation, providing adult education to 334 students aged 18 and older at its campus in Ward 8. In preparation for its Five-Year Charter Review, the school requests to amend its goals to more closely align with the Adult Education Performance Management Framework (AE PMF) requirements, adjusting the average score that the school must achieve for its Five, Ten, and Fifteen-Year charter reviews.

Pursuant to the School Reform Act, D.C. Code 38-1802 et seq., a charter school must submit a petition to revise its charter, which includes its goals and academic achievement expectations.

- Comments must be submitted on or before September 17, 2018.
